# MENTORSHIP AND THERAPEUTIC WORK THROUGH ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE COMMUNITY SETTINGS

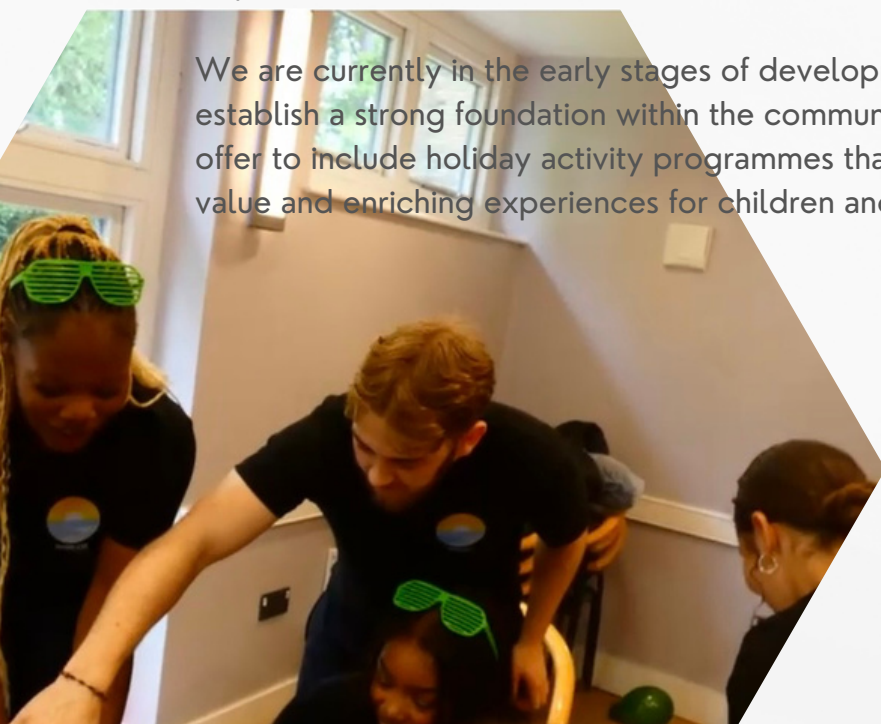
Our therapeutic work within the community is designed to create safe, supportive spaces where young people feel heard, valued, and understood. We aim to build trust and connection through consistent, meaningful engagement that prioritises emotional well-being.

We provide both group-based and one-to-one support, depending on individual needs, using creative and active methods such as art, sports, and team-based community activities. These sessions not only support mental health and self-expression, but also help young people build confidence, social skills, and positive relationships with peers and trusted adults.

We recognise that academic pressure can be both a source and a symptom of stress. When young people are struggling emotionally, their studies often suffer as a result. To address this, we will also offer tutoring support, ensuring that those who need extra help with their learning are not left behind. This academic support will complement our wellbeing work, reinforcing a holistic approach that nurtures both mind and achievement.

In addition to therapeutic and academic support, we will offer employability guidance and career advice. Young people will have access to workshops on CV writing, interview preparation, and opportunities to explore different career paths, helping them to plan for their future with confidence.

We are currently in the early stages of development, starting with single-day events to establish a strong foundation within the community. Our long-term goal is to expand our offer to include holiday activity programmes that continue to provide both therapeutic value and enriching experiences for children and young people throughout the year.
